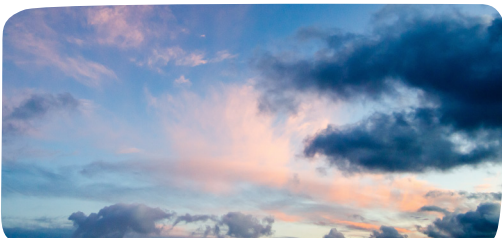


# The Creation of the World
